Last school year, we provided free programming and support to 34,549 students, 2,664 of those received ongoing, case-managed support. Of those...









15% of NC students who enter high school each fall will not graduate within four or even five years... 1 in 50 will drop out.



Students who drop out are at increased risk of being chronically unemployed and relying on government assistance; they face poor health outcomes, high rates of incarceration and are six times more likely to become a young parent.
